## APRIL 3RD, 6PM CALLED BUSINESS MEETING

The Columbarium Committee makes the motion that the Trustees be authorized to sign a contract with Nielsen Construction for up to \$250,000 for construction of a columbarium at First Baptist Waynesboro and the Columbarium Committee's approval of other vendor invoices for payment. Both Nielsen invoices and other vendor invoices would be for not more than \$250,000. Funding will be a combination of up front sales of niches and memorial plaques with any additional funds needed to be borrowed from First Baptist endowment funds at a repayment and interest rate as set by the Stewardship Committee.
